This conference will deal with current discoveries in the field of neurobiology and their wider significance. Can the recent discoveries in brain research throw new light on the theory of general cognitive patterns, for example, as treated in the work of C. G. Jung, C. P. Lévi-Strauss, and other structuralists? What kinds of concepts, methods, and testable hypotheses will the neurobiological discoveries stimulate for our understanding of religion and mythology?
