

ERRATUM

- Page 951, last line of first paragraph: in the reference (Çaïkaräcäya 1958) it should be spelt (Śaïkaräcärya 1958).
- Page 954, six lines from the bottom, in the reference (Çaïkaräcäya 1972) it should be spelt (Śaïkaräcärya 1972).
